Fig. 4 Normalized On-Resistance vs. Temperature

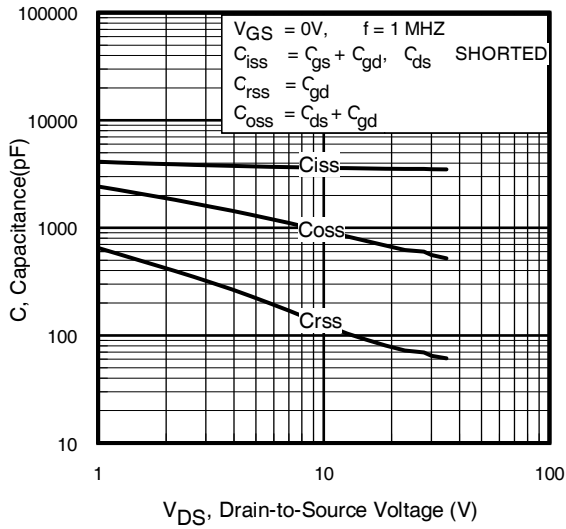


Fig 5. Typical Capacitance vs. Drain-to-Source Voltage

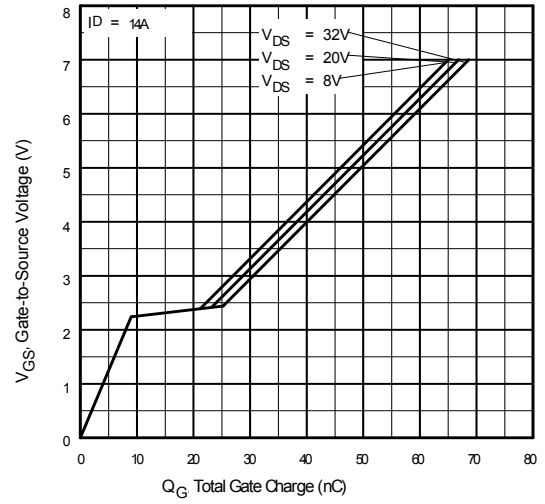


Fig 6. Typical Gate Charge vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage

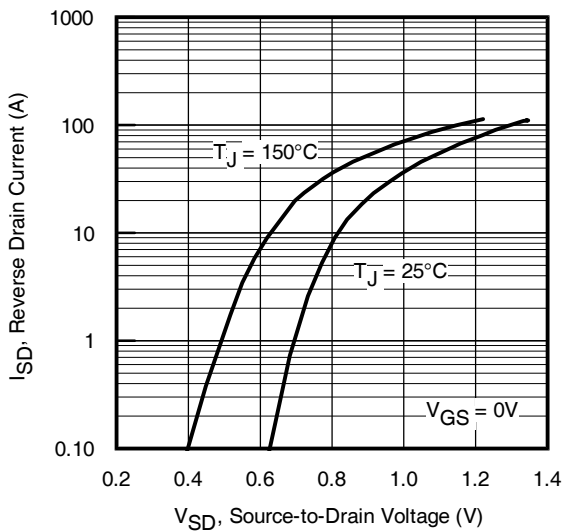


Fig 7. Typical Source-to-Drain Diode Forward Voltage

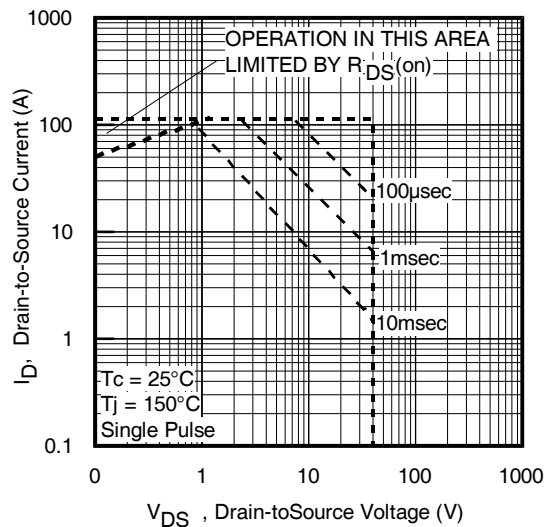
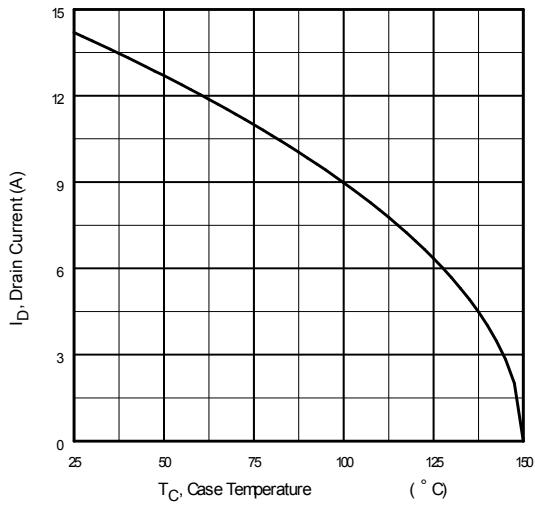
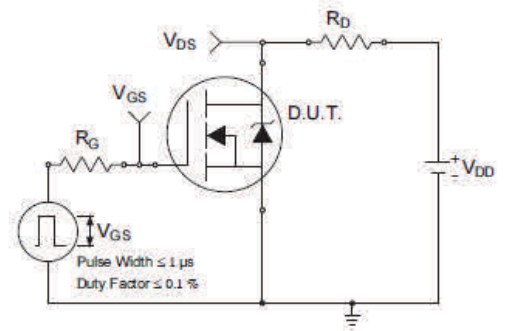
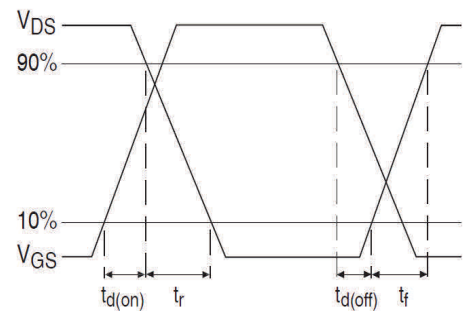
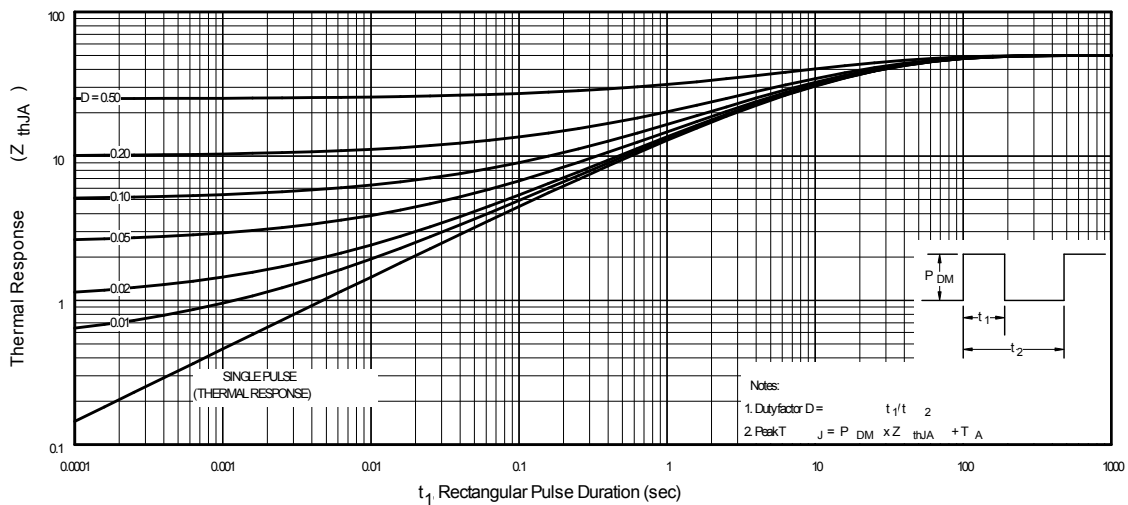


Fig 8. Maximum Safe Operating Area

Fig 11. Maximum Effective Transient Thermal Impedance, Junction-to-Ambient

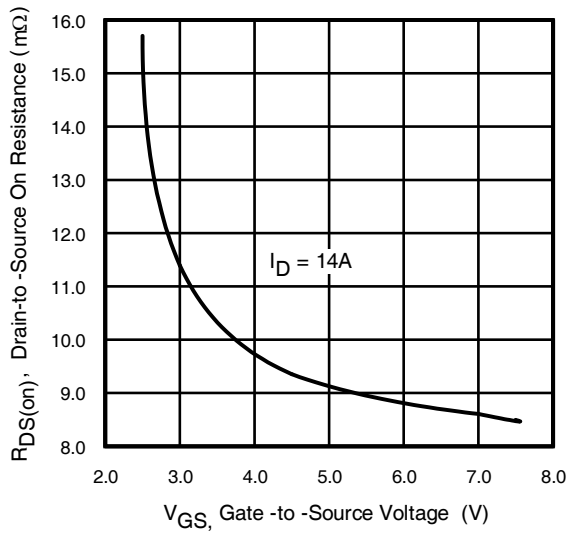


Fig 12. Typical On-Resistance Vs. Gate Voltage

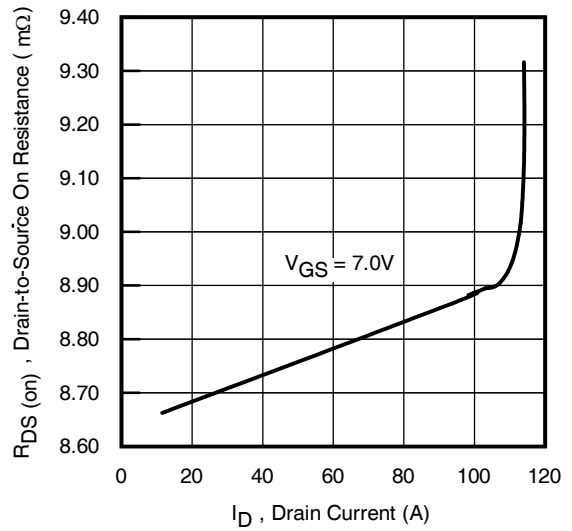


Fig 13. Typical On-Resistance Vs. Drain Current

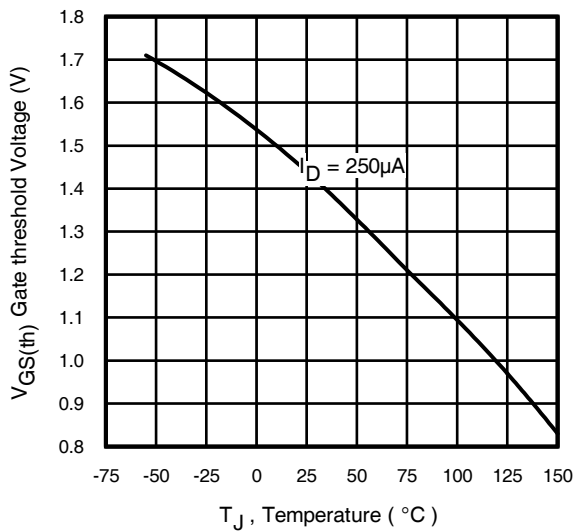


Fig. 14. Typical Threshold Voltage Vs. Junction Temperature

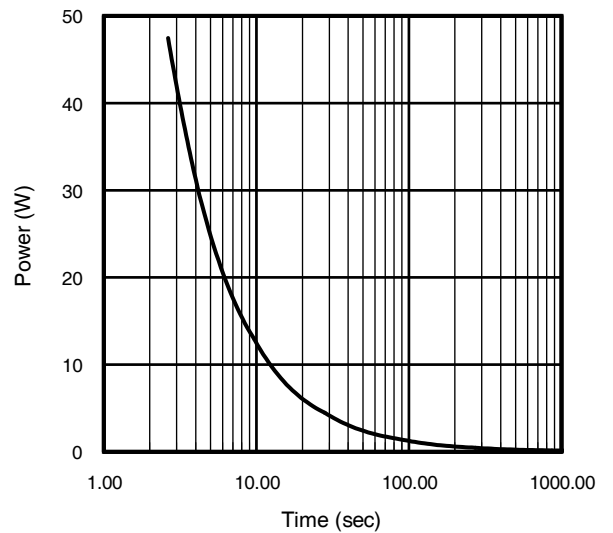


Fig 15. Typical Power Vs. Time

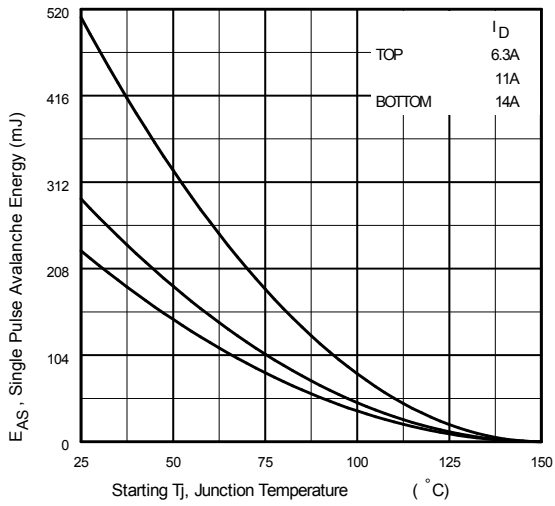


Fig 16a. Maximum Avalanche Energy vs. Drain Current

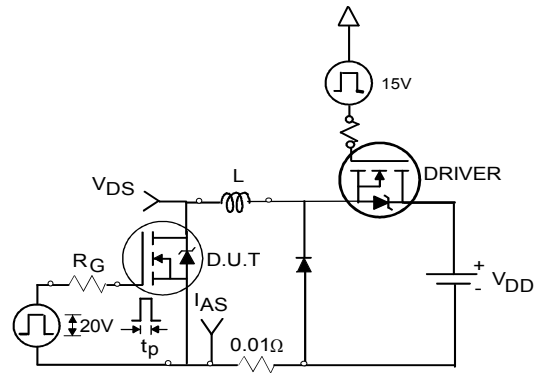


Fig 16b. Unclamped Inductive Test Circuit

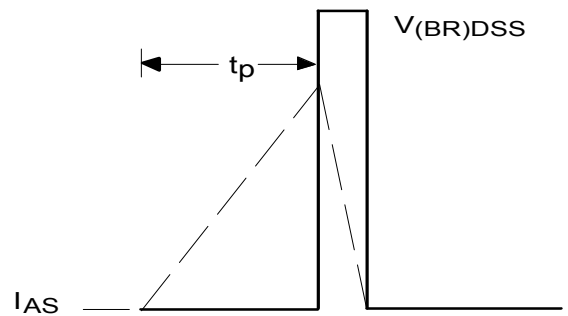


Fig 16c. Unclamped Inductive Waveforms

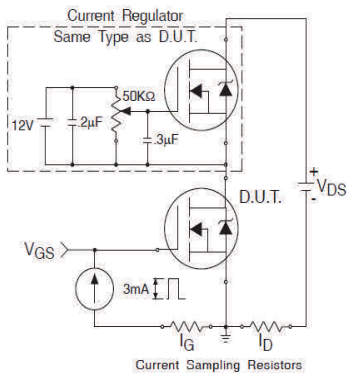


Fig 17. Gate Charge Test Circuit

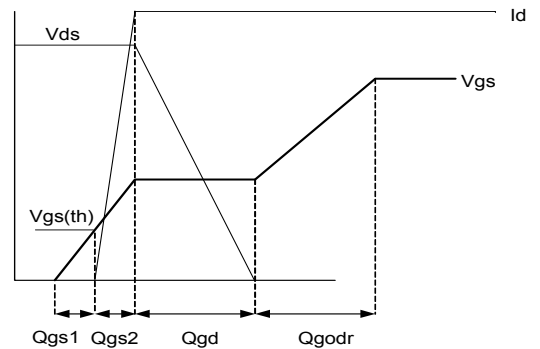
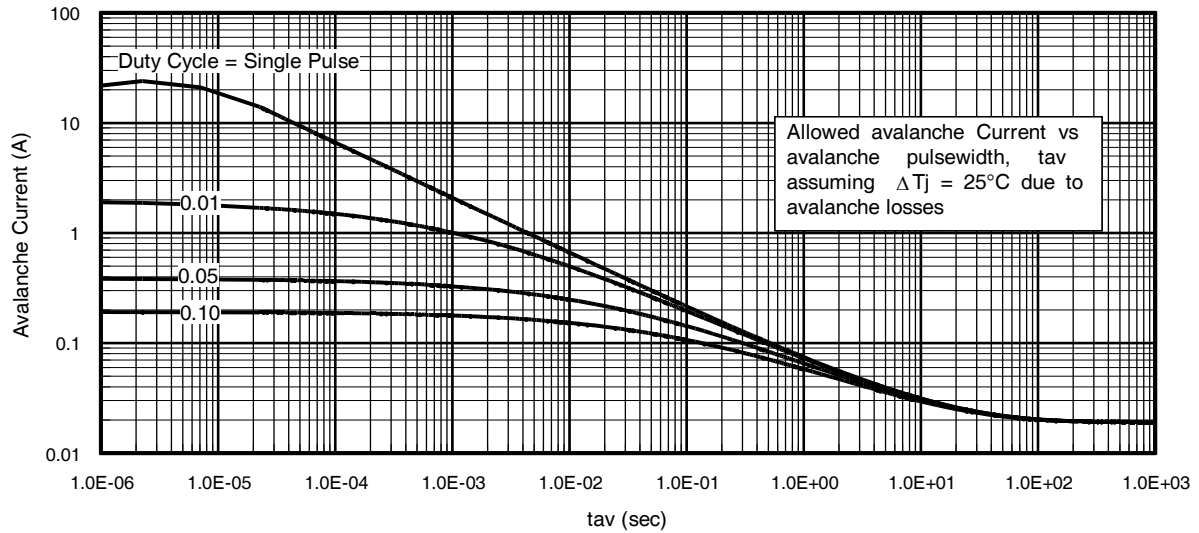
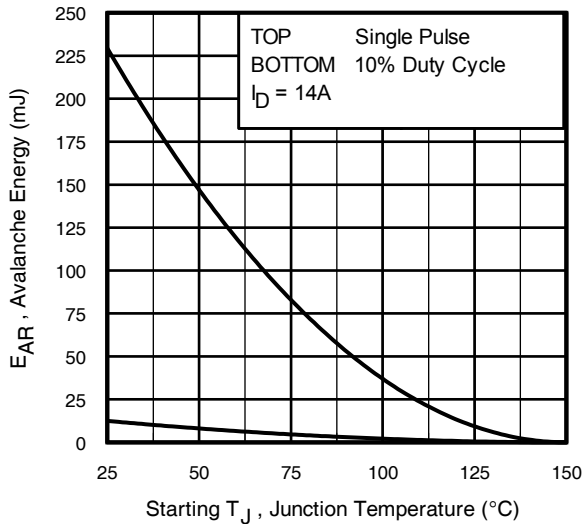


Fig 18. Basic Gate Charge Waveform

**Notes on Repetitive Avalanche Curves , Figures 19, 20:
(For further info, see AN-1005 at www.infineon.com)**

1. Avalanche failures assumption:
Purely a thermal phenomenon and failure occurs at a temperature far in excess of T_{jmax} . This is validated for every part type.
2. Safe operation in Avalanche is allowed as long as T_{jmax} is not exceeded.
3. Equation below based on circuit and waveforms shown in Figures 16b, 16c.
4. $P_{D(ave)}$ = Average power dissipation per single avalanche pulse.
5. BV = Rated breakdown voltage (1.3 factor accounts for voltage increase during avalanche).
6. I_{av} = Allowable avalanche current.
7. ΔT = Allowable rise in junction temperature, not to exceed T_{jmax} (assumed as 25°C in Figure 11, 16).

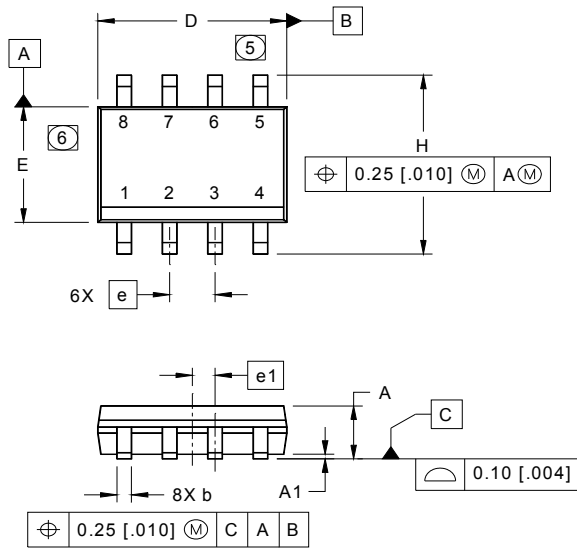

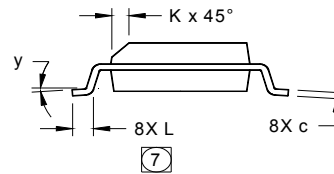

Fig 20. Maximum Avalanche Energy vs. Temperature

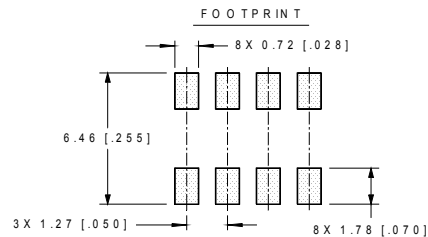
